# Summary of Benefits

### You have choices about how to get your Medicare benefits

One choice is to get your Medicare benefits through Original Medicare (fee-for-service Medicare). Original Medicare is run directly by the Federal government.

Another choice is to get your Medicare benefits by joining a Medicare health plan (such as **PacificSource Medicare Explorer 6 (PPO)**).

### Who can join?

To join **PacificSource Medicare Explorer 6 (PPO)**, you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, and live in our service area. Our service area includes the following counties in Idaho: Ada, Blaine, Boise, Camas, Canyon, Cassia, Elmore, Gem, Gooding, Jerome, Lincoln, Minidoka, Owyhee, Payette, Twin Falls, Valley, and Washington.

### Which doctors and hospitals can I use?

**PacificSource Medicare Explorer 6 (PPO)** has a network of doctors, hospitals, and other providers. If you use the providers in our network, you may pay less for your covered services. But if you want to, you can also use providers that are not in our network.

### What do we cover?

Like all Medicare health plans, we cover everything that Original Medicare covers – and more.

- **Our plan members get all of the benefits covered by Original Medicare. For some of these benefits, you may pay more in our plan than you would in Original Medicare.** For others, you may pay less.
- **Our plan members also get more than what is covered by Original Medicare.** Some of the extra benefits are outlined in this booklet.

**PacificSource Medicare Explorer 6 (PPO)** covers Part B drugs including chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider. However, this plan does **not** cover Part D prescription drugs.

# Summary of Benefits

January 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016

## Monthly Premium, Deductible, and Limits on How Much You Pay for Covered Services

<b>How much is the monthly premium?</b>	\$24 per month. In addition, you must keep paying your Medicare Part B premium.
<b>How much is the deductible?</b>	This plan does not have a deductible.
<b>Is there any limit on how much I will pay for my covered services?</b>	<p>Yes. Like all Medicare health plans, our plan protects you by having yearly limits on your out-of-pocket costs for medical and hospital care.</p> <p>Your yearly limit(s) in this plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• \$3,400 for services you receive from in-network providers.</li><li>• \$5,000 for services you receive from any provider. Your limit for services received from in-network providers will count toward this limit.</li></ul> <p>If you reach the limit on out-of-pocket costs, you keep getting covered hospital and medical services and we will pay the full cost for the rest of the year.</p> <p>Please note that you will still need to pay your monthly premiums.</p>
<b>Is there a limit on how much the plan will pay?</b>	Our plan has a coverage limit every year for certain in-network benefits. Contact us for the services that apply.

## Covered Medical and Hospital Benefits

- Services with a <sup>1</sup> may require prior authorization.
- Services with a <sup>2</sup> may require a referral from your doctor.

<b>Chiropractic Care</b>	<p>Manipulation of the spine to correct a subluxation (when 1 or more of the bones of your spine move out of position):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In-network: \$10 co-pay</li><li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li></ul>
<b>Dental Services</b>	<p>Limited dental services (this does not include services in connection with care, treatment, filling, removal, or replacement of teeth):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In-network: \$35 co-pay</li><li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li></ul>

<b>Durable Medical Equipment</b> (wheelchairs, oxygen, etc.) <sup>1</sup>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: 20% of the cost</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 0-40% of the cost, depending on the equipment</li> </ul>
<b>Emergency Care</b>	<p>\$75 co-pay</p> <p>If you are immediately admitted to the hospital, you do not have to pay your share of the cost for emergency care. See the "Inpatient Hospital Care" section of this booklet for other costs.</p>
<b>Foot Care</b> (podiatry services)	<p>Foot exams and treatment if you have diabetes-related nerve damage and/or meet certain conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: \$35 co-pay</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li> </ul>
<b>Hearing Services</b>	<p>Exam to diagnose and treat hearing and balance issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: \$35 co-pay</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li> </ul> <p>Routine hearing exam (for up to 1 every year):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: \$35 co-pay</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li> </ul>

<b>Home Health Care</b> <sup>1</sup>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: 10% of the cost</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li> </ul>
	<p>Inpatient visit: Our plan covers up to 190 days in a lifetime for inpatient mental health care in a psychiatric hospital. The inpatient hospital care limit does not apply to inpatient mental services provided in a general hospital.</p> <p>Our plan covers 90 days for an inpatient hospital stay.</p> <p>Our plan also covers 60 "lifetime reserve days." These are "extra" days that we cover. If your hospital stay is longer than 90 days, you can use these extra days. But once you have used up these extra 60 days, your inpatient hospital coverage will be limited to 90 days.</p>

<b>Transportation</b>	Not covered
<b>Urgently Needed Services</b>	\$35 co-pay

<b>Preventive Care</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-network: You pay nothing</li> <li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li> </ul> <p>Our plan covers many preventive services, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Abdominal aortic aneurysm screening</li> <li>• Alcohol misuse counseling</li> <li>• Bone mass measurement</li> <li>• Breast cancer screening (mammogram)</li> </ul>

- Cardiovascular disease (behavioral therapy)
- Cardiovascular screenings
- Cervical and vaginal cancer screening
- Colorectal cancer screenings (Colonoscopy, Fecal occult blood test, Flexible sigmoidoscopy)
- Depression screening
- Diabetes screenings
- HIV screening
- Medical nutrition therapy services
- Obesity screening and counseling
- Prostate cancer screenings (PSA)
- Sexually transmitted infections screening and counseling
- Tobacco use cessation counseling (counseling for people with no sign of tobacco-related disease)
- Vaccines, including Flu shots, Hepatitis B shots, Pneumococcal shots
- "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit (one-time)
- Yearly "Wellness" visit

Any additional preventive services approved by Medicare during the contract year will be covered.

## Hospice

You pay nothing for hospice care from a Medicare-certified hospice. You may have to pay part of the costs for drugs and respite care. Hospice is covered outside of our plan. Please contact us for more details.

## Inpatient Care

### Inpatient Hospital Care<sup>1</sup>

Our plan covers an unlimited number of days for an inpatient hospital stay.

- In-network:
  - \$225 co-pay per day for days 1 through 7
  - You pay nothing per day for days 8 through 90
  - You pay nothing per day for days 91 and beyond
- Out-of-network:
  - \$350 co-pay per day for days 1 through 7
  - You pay nothing per day for days 8 and beyond

### Inpatient Mental Health Care

For inpatient mental health care, see the "Mental Health Care" section of this booklet.

### Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)<sup>1</sup>

Our plan covers up to 100 days in a SNF.

- In-network:
  - \$40 co-pay per day for days 1 through 20
  - \$125 co-pay per day for days 21 through 100
- Out-of-network:
  - 20% of the cost per stay
  - 20% of the cost per day for days 1 through 100

## Prescription Drug Benefits

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	For Part B drugs such as chemotherapy drugs <sup>1</sup> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In-network: 20% of the cost</li><li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li></ul>
<b>How much do I pay?</b>	Other Part B drugs <sup>1</sup> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In-network: 20% of the cost</li><li>• Out-of-network: 20% of the cost</li></ul>

Our plan does **not** cover Part D prescription drug.

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## Optional Benefits (you must pay an extra premium each month for these benefits)

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<b>Package 1: Preventive Dental</b>	Benefits include: Preventive Dental
<b>How much is the monthly premium?</b>	Additional \$24 per month. You must keep paying your Medicare Part B premium and your \$24 monthly plan premium.
<b>How much is the deductible?</b>	This package does not have a deductible.
<b>Is there any limit on how much the plan will pay?</b>	No. There is no limit to how much our plan will pay for benefits in this package.

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PacificSource Community Health Plans is an HMO/PPO Plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in PacificSource Medicare depends on contract renewal. Limitations, co-payments, and restrictions may apply. Benefits, premium and co-payments/co-insurance may change on January 1 of each year. The provider network may change at any time. You will receive notice when necessary.
